The Supported Independent Living Program for Youth Requires: TRANSITIONAL SUPPORT WORKERS for our COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAM

Details: This position involves supporting youth between the ages of 16 and 22 in the community. The program serves a variety of youth. Some youth have complex issues and are considered high risk. Their issues may be related to addictions, mental health, homelessness, and developmental challenges. Comfortability with supporting youth with these issues and being able to connect with and develop helping relationships with youth is essential to this position. Note: This position will start working in the SIL Program but in the future the successful applicant may work in any of the Community based Children Services Programs (ie Foster Care/Family Intervention).

Please note: This is a temporary 1-year position - until April 2025.

Hours: 40 hours per week, Monday to Friday with two evenings per week; flexibility is required to meet the needs of the youth with occasional weekend shifts. An on-call rotation every 7-9 weeks for one week, 24 hours per day.
