Reporting to the Program Supervisor- The Community Youth Worker position is responsible for providing supervision, support and counseling to youth in the program. Their responsibilities include case planning and management, and the coordination of activities for the youth. They work effectively as part of a team that collaborates with the youth and their support group to assist them in achieving their goals.
