McMan's Family Support and Respite Program in Fort McMurray is seeking to recruit dedicated casual support workers to provide direct care, support and guidance to children 4 - 17 years old with physical and developmental disabilities, mental health disorders and some complex behaviours who are in the Family Support and Respite program.

Responsibilities will include fostering community relationships, facilitating recreation and leisure, and care and safety of the children. The successful candidate will work effectively as part of a team that collaborates with the child, the family and their support network to assist the family in achieving their goals. **Please note there are dogs/ cats in clients' homes.**

Hours: Casual employment with various shifts available on weekdays, evenings, after-school hours, school holidays, and weekends.

Location: Fort McMurray, Alberta.

- Act as a strong advocate for individuals in the community
- Work effectively as a team with the individuals and their support team to help achieve their goals

- Completion of a High School Diploma.
- One (1) year directly related experience working with youth and families. Equivalencies may be considered.
- Experience working with children with disabilities and behaviour management.
- Must be able to perform lifts and transfers and have experience with G-Tube feeding
- Security Clearance Check; including the Vulnerable Persons Sector Check (from within the last 6 months)
- Children Services Intervention Record Check (from within the last 6 months)
- Emergency First Aid—Level C CPR + AED.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license with a minimum of 3 years of verifiable driving experience, reliable vehicle, and auto insurance (minimum \$2 million coverage).
- Experience working with non-verbal children and challenging behaviors is an asset.
- Ability to implement approved restrictive practices and assist with personal care.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Computer/Word processing skills
