Mentoring Youth and Young Adults from Care (MYAC) program seeks to provide high quality and consistent mentors to young adults ages 16-24 with in-care status or who are transitioning out of care. It strives for its mentors to foster and maintain positive, supportive and reciprocal relationships with mentees, committing to a minimum of 1 hour per week for mentoring.

We need your help to find volunteer mentors!

The key responsibilities of this position will include:

- Assist in volunteer engagement and recruitment specifically for potential MYAC volunteer mentors. MYAC volunteer mentors will be matched with young adults who have lived experience being involved with, or transition from, government care.
- Leverage your connections with the community to promote the MYAC volunteer program to qualified individuals; encouraging them to apply to be volunteer mentors to young adults ages 16 – 24 who are currently enrolled in the MYAC program.
- Deliver targeted recruitment messages across your network to new and existing contacts, community partners and employment connections regarding the need for MYAC volunteer mentors, resulting in new volunteer mentor applications.
- Connect with interested people and promote the MYAC program and the need for volunteer mentors, share information about the opportunities available for qualified individuals to volunteer to be a mentor to a young adult through the MYAC program.
- Engage and recruit a target of 50 volunteer applications to the MYAC by March 31, 2025. Incentive pay of \$100 per volunteer committed.

The successful candidate will have:

- Active and engaged community connections and multi-sector partnerships in the area of supporting vulnerable youth
- Experience working with vulnerable youth, and youth service systems
- Proven ability to engage individuals and groups of people
- Excellent oral communication skills including public speaking
- Hours of work are flexible, with evening and weekend availability as necessary
- A valid driver's license and access to a vehicle

Candidates must be capable of performing independently and have excellent interpersonal skills.
