Drive support workers provide transportation to vulnerable children, youth and adults with mental health disorders to support the family/youth to address needs that have brought them to the attention of Children's Services through access to family visitation, and other needs. Workers support access visitation between children and their families or extended families, maintaining connection of youth to their families and community. Please note that there is a potential for pets to be in the homes.

Hours: Variety of casual hours; flexibility is required as hours will include days, evenings, and weekends.
